

The Reality of Darkness EPHESIANS

- 5:8 "you were formerly darkness"
- 5:11 "Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them"
- 5:16 "the days are evil"

"Evil has never been experienced in a vague, abstract form."

1 And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, 2 in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.



10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.

"Be strong"

EPHESIANS

- endynamoō
 - Passive or middle imperative in the Greek text.
 - It probably meant both "allow the Lord to strengthen you" (passive) and "strengthen yourself in the Lord" (middle).
 - It is the Lord who provides the power in both cases.

"Finally, be strong (endynamoō) in the Lord and in the strength (kratos) of His might (ischys)"

• These same three words also appear in 1:19 –

"and what is the surpassing greatness of His *power (dynamis)* toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the *strength (kratos)* of His *might (ischys)*" The Lord's strength and might are available to us in our spiritual warfare.

Not only does God command us to be strong, but He gives us the means to accomplish it.

11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Paul's NT Vocabulary EPHESIANS

These Terms

Are used in both the New **Testament** and other classical Greek literature to denote geographical domain authority.

Ephesians 1:20b-22a EPHESIANS

20b He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule (arche) and authority (exousia) and power (dynamis) and dominion (kuriotes), and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22a And He put all things in subjection under His feet

10 so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers (arche) and the authorities (exousia) in the heavenly places.

12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers (arche), against the powers (exousia), against the world forces (kosmokrator) of this darkness, against the spiritual forces (pneumatikos) of wickedness in the heavenly places.






We Are The Temple EPHESIANS

- Corporately: 1 Corinthians 3:16
 - "Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"
- Individually: 1 Corinthians 6:19
 - "Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?"

19 So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, 20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, 21 in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, 22 in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

New Covenant Reality EPHESIANS

We are the place where God dwells

- the same presence that filled the
Tabernacle and the Temple in the
Old Testament.


What are the implications of this startling reality?

• Matthew 18:20 -

"For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst."

That's amazing.
But Wait, There's More!

The New Testament language we have looked at this morning, which in turn is informed by the Old Testament imagery of the Tabernacle and Temple. The truth is that wherever believers are and gather, the spiritual ground they occupy is sanctified amid the powers of darkness.



"If we could see with spiritual eyes, we would see a world of darkness peppered with Yahweh's presence, spreading out to meet each other, inexorably pressing and spreading out to take back the ground...from the enemy."



Life outside the protection of the church should be absolutely frightening.

The People of God, in whom is the Name of God and the presence of God, are surrounded, as they have been throughout redemptive history.

The prophets and apostles understood that but were not faint of heart.

There would be no surrender of holy ground in the midst of darkness.

A spiritual war is raging for the souls of men, and you must choose a side. Diplomacy is NOT an option.



- If we want to obey God and resist the devil, we are in for a struggle; it is not easy nor is it automatic.
- This is part of our human responsibility in progressive sanctification.
- Paul is clear that God alone saves, and yet, we have a responsibility to pursue holiness, both individually and corporately.

- Is not a primarily a physical one, though saying no to certain temptations may involve certain physical behavior.
- It is essentially warfare on the spiritual level with an enemy that we cannot see.
- This enemy is Satan and his hosts as well as the philosophies and feelings he promotes that characterize the world.
